<u>Camp Invention</u> is back for 2016! Camps are available at schools throughout Charlotte for rising first through sixth graders. Camp Invention is the only nationally recognized, non-profit elementary enrichment program backed by the National Inventors Hall of Fame.

<u>Project Scientist Summer Academy Camp</u> offers full-day camps for girls ages 4–12 at the UNC Charlotte Center City Campus. During each of six week-long camps, girls will learn from a tailored curriculum facilitated by highly skilled and credentialed educators, participate in hands-on experiments and field trips, and interact daily with female STEM role models from a variety of professional fields.
